It is best to contact the service provider by phone to ensure eligibility of services. An official agency referral may be needed in order to receive services. Please note that the listings in this directory are not meant to be a complete listing for the county. This is an easy reference guide for you to carry with you. Basic or Usual Proof/Documentation	
Vital Statistics Certified Copy of Birth or Death Certificates	Madison County Health Department, 306 Lafayette St., STE B; 740.852.3065.
Certified Copy of Divorce	Madison County Probate Court, 1 N. Main St., RM 205; 740.852.0756; \$0.25 each page – certification \$1.
Marriage License/Certified Copy of Marriage License	Madison County Probate Court, 1 N. Main St. RM 205; 740.852.0756; Current cost is \$5 per copy if married prior to 1993, 1993-present \$2.
Social Security Number	Social Security Administration, 2026 Main St., Springfield, OH, 45504; 937.325.0674 or 800.772.1213. There is no fee to make application or to submit a name change request. You must present some documents such as birth certificate and/or certified copy of marriage license in order to make an application.
Registration of Military Service Discharge	Only one copy is issued at the time of discharge. It is advisable to register your original at the County Recorder's Office in the County Administration Building. There is not a fee for this service. Should someone lose their original document, the County Recorder can issue a copy of the original DD214. A fee may apply.
Shot Records	Shot records are usually free from the health care provider unless the original document is repeatedly misplaced or there is an outstanding balance for services rendered.
Deeds, Wills, Rental, Leases, Insurance Papers, or any other Legally Binding Documents	Should be carefully stored and maintained. That location should be safe from fire, theft, and easily accessible. Be sure that another family member or responsible person knows where these documents are stored.

Suggested Steps for Parents to Ensure Service Delivery

Know Exactly What you need to obtain, learn, or explain. Be honest and factual. Be Patient!

Gather or Collect Basic documents about yourself and/or family; such things as birth certificates, business mailings envelopes, current bill records for rent/mortgage payments, utility payments, school or medical records, photo identification, pay stubs, and any other determination of status letters. Keep these documents handy, presentable, and out of the reach of children and pets.

Let Someone Know .. What you are planning to do. Know your rights and responsibilities. Be or become a registered voter.

Telephone The community resource first before making a trip to their office. Write down the name(s) of contact person, date, time, and whatever additional information you obtain. Check to see if an appointment or some preliminary procedure is required.

Allow Plenty Of travel and waiting time. Remember that there may be other people to be seen. Be prepared to travel by public transportation if other means fail or are not available. By all means, plan to be on time.

Be Prepared To clearly express your needs or concerns to all service contacts. If you feel a requested services has been unjustly denied or the procedure improperly administered, ask to meet/talk with the next higher authority. Present your complaint in writing as soon as possible after the meeting. Ask for an appointment after the meeting and file an appeal according to the guidelines provided by the service provider agency.
