#### CenterPoint Energy Home Weatherization Program

The Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) provides assistance to improve the energy efficiency of homes and reduce energy costs. A home inspection to identify the services necessary to improve energy efficiency will be scheduled. Ohioans with a household income at or

below 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines are eligible for the program. Families who have received assistance during the last 12 months under Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or Home Energy Assistance (HEAP) (does not include Emergency HEAP) are automatically income-eligible. HWAP can assist with services including furnace and hot water tank replacement/repair, insulation, and air sealing. Click on this <a href="LINK">LINK</a> to apply.
