Father engagement is a vital and integrated aspect of parent, family, and community engagement work. Head Start and Early Start staff engage fathers as advocates, lifelong educators, and first teachers of their children. Male family members and father figures serve key roles in the healthy development of their children and families, and have much to add to the Head Start community.

There are five ways fathers already support their child's learning each day:

- PLAY-Fathers play with their child to help them learn social skills.
- FOLLOW-Fathers follow their child's interests and encourage exploration and discovery.
- TALK-Fathers talk with their child about what they are doing and learning.
- LISTEN-Fathers listen to their child when they talk about their feelings and ideas.
- LOVE-Fathers love their child as a unique and special person.

February will be the last month of emergency Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) allotments. The USDA says the temporary boost to SNAP benefits, put in place during the COVID-19 pandemic, will end nationwide in 2023. Households that receive SNAP and Social Security benefits will see a decrease in their SNAP benefits because of the significant cost of living increase to Social Security benefits that went into effect Jan 1. - All MVCDC centers will CLOSE OR DELAY based on the school district the building resides in. (list is in the handbook)
- MVCDC will send out a closing announcement via call/text message through MVCDC's One Call Now system, in addition parents should follow the announcements on their local television and radio stations (WHIO, WDTN, WBNS, WSYX & WCMH) for their related school district.
- For 2- hour delays the following will apply:
  - \* Part-day centers there will be no AM session.
  - \* Full-Day/6-hour centers- will open at 10 am.
  - \* Sites located in a SCHOOL Building will follow the buildings arrival times.
