What is Policy Council? Head Start Policy Council Video When Head Start began in 1965, its founders understood that parents are es essential partners in educating young children. They felt parents should help decide how Head Start services can most benefit their family and other families in the community.

Head Start created the Policy Council as a formal leadership and policy-making role for parents. The Policy Council is a group of Head Start and Early Head Start parents and community members who help lead and make decisions about our program. Policy Council members are elected by the parents of children enrolled in the program.

The Policy Council meets monthly as a group. Members can serve for one year at a time, and for up to five years. They work closely with our program's management team and governing body to provide overall direction for the program.
