

VOTING IN OHIO PRIMARY WILL BE BY MAIL

Residents not registered to vote by the Feb. 18 deadline are not eligible for this election. Voters who already cast absentee ballots in the weeks before March 17 don't need to do anything else.

Registered voters wanting to cast a March primary ballot must complete the following steps:



Fill out an absentee ballot application at:

Wait for elections officials to mail you back the appropriate ballot



Cast your votes on that ballot



Mail it back to the board of elections, **postmarked by April 27th**

Voters must specify they're asking for a ballot for the March 17 primary and whether they want a Republican ballot, a Democrat ballot, or an "issues-only" ballot.
