

Dear MVCDC Families,

There was a COVID-19 case in Montgomery County this week at our Twin Towers location. A non-classroom staff notified us over the weekend that she had tested positive. Fortunately, no other staff or children were exposed. The center remained open and no-one else needed to quarantine. As a precaution the center was disinfected with the electrostatic sprayer.

Since our re-opening in June we have had a total of 18 positive COVID-19 staff cases and 2 children who tested positive after exposure to a family member. MVCDC is a large organization with 27 different locations and over 500 staff serving over 2,000 children across several counties.

As we work together to prevent the spread of the virus:

- **Please continue to follow the safety practices we know help stop the spread of the virus! Wear a mask, keep 6 feet apart and stay safe!!**
- Please keep in mind Ohio's travel advisory for this week which includes **Idaho, Iowa, Indiana, Kansas, Nevada, South Dakota, Wyoming, and Wisconsin.** If you have traveled to any of these states, you will need to quarantine at home for 14 days before returning.
- **Please consider getting a FLU shot this year for you and your child.**

As we prepare for the winter months and possible closings due to inclement weather, we will be using **One Call Now** to communicate with you. **Please make sure we have current phone numbers for your family. One Call Now is a quick and easy way to send messages and keep you informed.**
