

Dear MVCDC Families,

We have 7 COVID-19 cases to let you know about:

- 1 case involved a child at Springfield Children’s Center, resulting in 4 staff members and 8 children needing to quarantine and their classroom being closed.
- 1 case involved a transportation staff member in Medway, resulting in 1 staff person and 18 children quarantining.
- 1 case involved a non-classroom staff member at Miami View.
- 4 classroom staff members at the Clark ECEC tested positive, initially resulting in 5 other staff members and 24 children needing to quarantine. To ensure everyone’s safety, we closed the program December 15th.

Ohio’s COVID-19 numbers continue to be alarming — and positive cases at our sites reflect that. **Please be exceedingly careful during the holidays as you make hard decisions about whom you gather with and invite into your homes.** This virus can be devastating, and vaccines are coming! We just need to continue social distancing, wearing a mask and washing our hands frequently.
