COVID-19 Dashboard

Updated 3/31/21

We have 1 new COVID-19 case to report this week:

- 1 case involved a classroom staff member at the **Early Childhood Education Center** in Clark County, resulting in 3 additional staff and 19 children needing to quarantine. Two classrooms were closed.

Here are cumulative statistics that illustrate how MVCDC has been impacted:

- As of Wednesday, March 31, we have had 113 positive cases since June 12 when we had our first incidence.
- 100 staff members and 13 children spread across 19 of our 27 sites have tested positive – 8 sites have had no cases.
- 4 sites have had to totally close for a period of time, and 53 classrooms have had to be closed for 14 days.
